THE UNITED STATES ATTORNEY CHARGES:

COUNT ONE

At all times relevant to this Information,

General Allegations

- 1. Defendant **ELLIS K. McCOY** was employed as the Transportation Division Manager, Parking Operations, Portland Bureau of Transportation, in Portland, Oregon. Defendant **McCOY** was the City of Portland employee primarily responsible for the day-to-day operation of the City of Portland's smart parking meter program.
- 2. The City of Portland's Bureau of Transportation was a government agency that received, in each calendar year, federal benefits and/or federal assistance in excess of \$10,000.

The Bribery Conduct

3. From approximately June 2004 through July 2011, defendant **ELLIS K. McCOY**, being an agent and employee of the City of Portland Bureau of Transportation, accepted and agreed to accept items of value intending to be influenced or rewarded in connection with the business of,

and the transactions of, the City of Portland's Bureau of Transportation relating to the City of Portland's smart parking meter program. Specifically, defendant **ELLIS K. McCOY** accepted and agreed to accept:

- (a) During the period June 2004 through November 2006, 11 checks payable to his consulting company, EKM Consulting, totaling \$37,134.24;
- (b) During the period August 2006 through September 2008, currency in the approximate amount of \$87,000;
- (c) During the period June 2004 through July 2011, gifts and travel of undetermined value.

All in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 666.
