## NE Klickitat Green Street Project

The city is designing a series of green street facilities on NE Morris, Siskiyou and Klickitat streets between N Vancouver Avenue and NE 67th Avenue (see maps on back). The project includes constructing 43 green street facilities, including vegetated curb extensions and stormwater planters, along more than 60 blocks.

The design includes a rain garden on NE Klickitat between NE Alameda Street and NE 38th Avenue. The project will also narrow NE Klickitat between NE 23rd and 24th avenues at The Madeleine School, construct new ADA ramps, and add "bulb out" corners to shorten crossing distances for pedestrians.

After holding a series of public meetings, the city designated this 60-block project area as a bike boulevard. This project will enhance pedestrian safety and improve bicycle movement through northeast Portland, while keeping stormwater runoff out of the sewer system to help reduce combined sewer overflows and basement sewer backups.

### Construction Methods

The city's contractor will likely use open trench construction to improve streets and to install stormwater management facilities, inlets and inlet leads. New green street facilities will remove some on-street parking spaces and some street trees. The city will replace most of the street trees removed.
