Providing an email address allows the Revenue Bureau to send an electronic notice next year to remind you to file. Electronic notices are the only notices that will be sent in future tax years.
- To determine if an adult is an "income earner", all income is considered, regardless of amount, whether it is taxable or non-taxable. Income can be from wages, self-employment, investments, rentals, retirement (including Social Security), disability, unemployment, spousal/child support or any other source.
